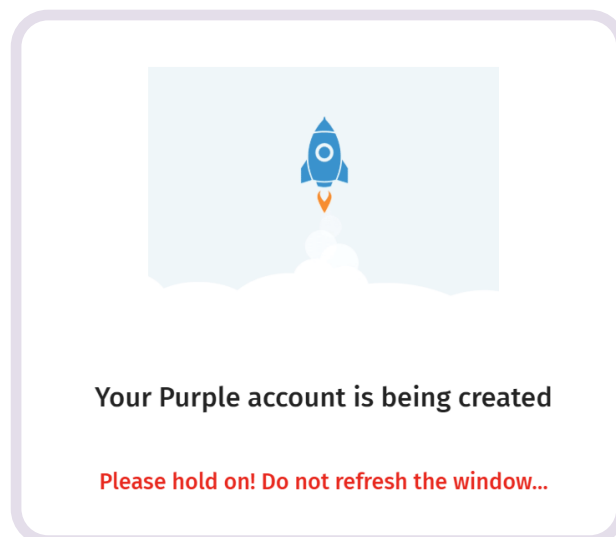

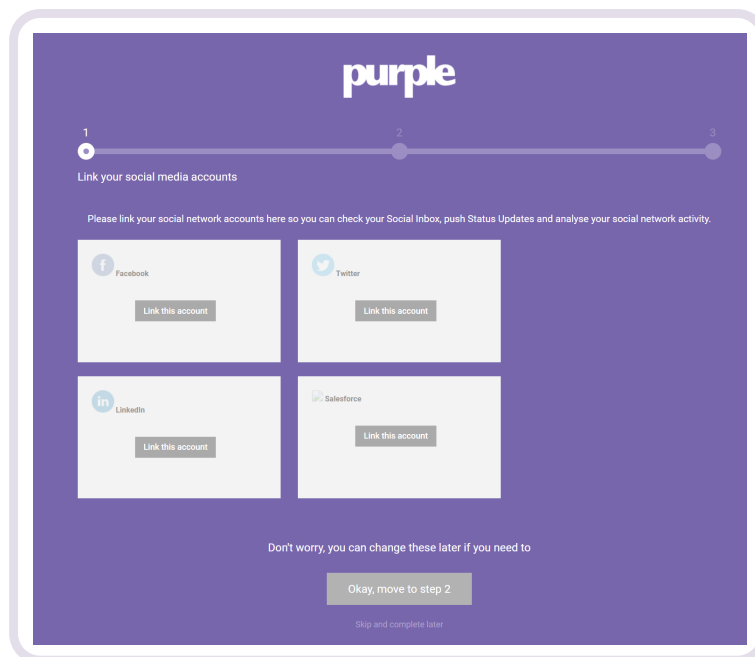

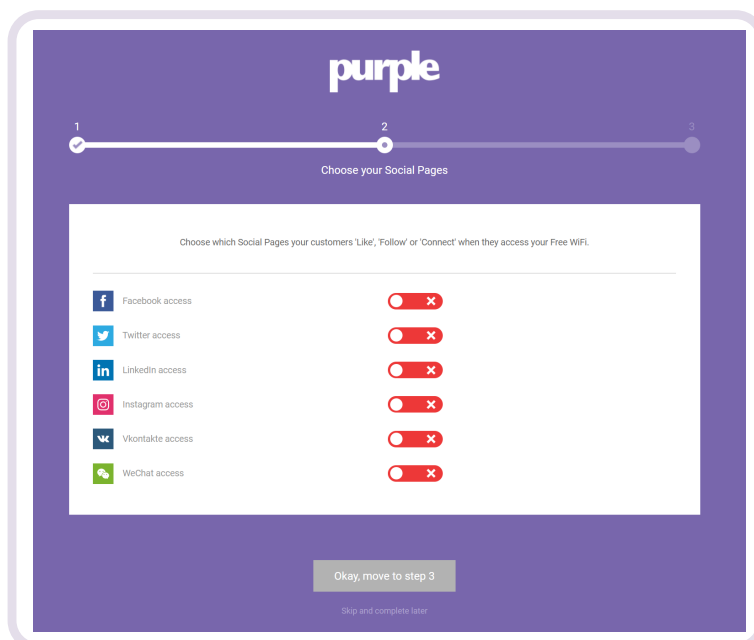
## 1 – Link your social media accounts

## 2 – Choose how your end users can log in to your WiFi service


If you would like to enable Facebook, Twitter or LinkedIn to speed up your end user login please enable here.



### 3 – Add your Instant On Access Point(s)

You now need to register your Instant On Access Point. Please choose 'Aruba Instant On AP' from the list and enter the Access Point MAC address. Click Save details, and proceed to add more Access Points in the same way if you have more than one.

Next, click the 'View Manual Online' or 'Download Manual' button – this will provide you with the guide on how to enable Purple on your Instant On AP.
